

1 Privacy policy

In the following we inform about the collection of personal data when using our websites. Personal data is all data that is personally available to you, eg. Name, address, e-mail addresses, user behavior

1.1 Name and contact details of the controller and the company data protection officer

1.2 Collection and storage of personal data as well as the nature and purpose of their use

a. When visiting the websites

In the case of the informational use of our websites www.euwiro.de, ie if you provide us with information, the browser used on your terminal automatically sends information to the server of our website. This information is temporarily stored in a so-called log file. The following information will be collected without your intervention and stored until the automated deletion at the end of each session or after seven days at the latest:

-) IP address of the requesting terminal,
-) Date and time of access,
-) Name and URL of the retrieved file,
-) Website from which access takes place (Referrer-URL),
-) used browser and if applicable the operating system of your terminal as well as the name of your access provider.

The data mentioned are processed by us for the following purposes:

-) Ensuring a smooth connection setup of the website,
-) Ensuring comfortable use of our website,
-) Evaluation of system security and stability,
-) to optimize the content offered (see also section 4 below) as well as
-) for further administrative purposes.

The legal basis for the data processing is Art. 6 para. 1 p. 1 f) GDPR. Our legitimate interest follows from the data collection purposes listed above. In no case we use the collected data for the purpose of drawing conclusions about you.

In addition, we may use analytics services when visiting our website. Further details can be found in sections 4 and 5 of this privacy policy.

b. Using our contact form

For questions of any kind, we offer you the opportunity to contact us via a provided on the website www.euwiro.de form. It is necessary to provide a valid e-mail address so that we know who the request came from and to answer it. Further information can be provided voluntarily.

The data processing for the purpose of contacting us takes place according to Art. 6 para. 1 p. 1 a) GDPR on the basis of your voluntarily granted consent.

The personal data collected by us for the use of the contact form will be automatically deleted after completion of the request made by you.

1.3 Disclosure of data

A transfer of your personal data to third parties for purposes other than those listed below does not take place.

We pass on your personal data only to third parties, if according to GDPR Art. 6 Abs.1

-) S.1a) You consent to the processing of your personal data for one or more specific purposes
-) S.1b) Processing is required for the performance of a contract of which the data subject is a party or necessary for the performance of any pre-contractual action which may be requested by the data subject.
-) S.1c) dprocessing is required to fulfill a legal obligation to which the controller is subject
-) S.1f to assert, exercise or defend your rights, and there is no reason to believe that you have an overriding legitimate interest in not disclosing your information

In such a case, you will separately inform us on what basis and to which recipients a transfer of your data takes place

1.4 Cookies

1.4.1 Cookie Note Confirmation

The cookie duration is limited to 30 days. By clicking on "**Ok, understood**" the visitor confirms the knowledge of the use of cookies on our website. The note will not be displayed on re-visit, if the cookie has not been deleted by the user until then, or he calls the page with another browser.

1.4.2 Die Session Cookies

The internet provider sets session cookies (for example: TS0152667c). They are necessary and harmless.

-) are necessary for the operation (among other things fast delivery of the sides)
-) do **not** collect personal information
-) do not collect data
-) are generally stored in the browser
-) can be deleted there by the user
-) however, they are only valid until the end of the session and are then automatically deleted by the browser

We also want to inform you about the existence of third-party cookies that are unrelated to the EUWIRO website and may be able to save the preferences and use of external services such as Google.

1.5 Analytics

The provider performs the following analyzes :

-) Using this website like
-) Browser type / version,
-) used operating system,
-) Referrer URL (the previously visited page),
-) Host name of the accessing terminal (IP address),

The data provided to us will be displayed anonymously graphically.

1.6 Social Media Plug-ins

We are currently using the following social media plug-ins:

-) Facebook
-) Twitter
-) Xing
-) LinkedIn

When you visit our site, no personal information is passed on to the providers of the plug-ins.

The provider of the plug-in is displayed by us by means of a logo.

If you use our offer for social media plug-ins via the respective button, the plug-in provider receives the information that you have accessed the corresponding website of our online service.

In addition, the data referred to in point 1.2 of this declaration will be transmitted.

In the case of Facebook and Xing, according to the respective providers in Germany, the IP address is anonymized immediately after collection. By activating the plug-in, personal data will be transmitted by you to the respective plug-in provider and stored there (with US providers in the USA)

Since the plug-in provider carries out the data collection, in particular via cookies, we recommend that you delete all cookies before clicking on the displayed link via the security settings of your browser.

We have no influence on the collected data and data processing operations, nor are we aware of the full extent of the data collection, the purpose of processing, the retention periods. We also have no information to delete the data collected by the plug-in provider.

The plug-in provider stores the data collected about you as usage profiles and uses them for purposes of advertising, market research and / or tailor-made website design. Such an evaluation is carried out in particular (also for non-logged-in users) for the presentation of needs-based advertising and to inform other users of the social network about your activities on our website. You have the right to object to the formation of these user profiles, whereby you must contact the respective plug-in provider to exercise this.

Through the plug-ins, we offer you the opportunity to interact with social networks and other users so that we can improve our offer and make it more interesting for you as a user. The legal basis for the use of the plug-ins is Article 6 (1) sentence 1f) of the GDPR .

The data transfer takes place regardless of whether you have an account with the plug-in provider and are logged in there. If you are logged into the plug-in provider, your data collected from us will be assigned directly to your existing account with the plug-in provider.

If you activate the activated button and eg. link the page, the plug-in provider also stores this information in your user account and shares it with your contacts publicly.

We recommend that you log out regularly after using a social network, but especially before activating the button, as this will prevent you from being assigned to your profile with the plug-in provider.

- IP address, (start / destination) address entered during route planning.

If you do not want Google to collect, process or use information about you, disable JavaScript in your browser settings. However, you will not be able to use the map display in this case.

1.9 Rights of persons affected

You have the right,

-) in accordance with Art. 15 GDPR, free of charge information about your personal data processed by us, in particular about the processing purposes, the category of personal data, the categories of recipients to whom your data was or are being disclosed, and the planned ones To require storage duration;
-) in accordance with Art. 16 GDPR, immediately demand the correction of incorrect or completed personal data stored by us;
-) to demand the deletion of your personal data stored with our provider according to Art. 17 GDPR, as far as the processing for the exercise of the right to freedom of expression and information, for the fulfillment of a legal obligation, for reasons of the public interest or for the assertion, exercise or defense of legal claims is required;
-) to request the restriction of the processing of your personal data in accordance with Art. 18 GDPR;
-) in accordance with Art. 20 GDPR, to receive your personal data provided to us in a structured, standard and machine-readable format or to request the transfer to another person in charge (data portability);
-) pursuant to Art. 7 para. 3 GDPR your once granted consent to revoke against us at any time. As a result, we are not allowed to continue the data processing based on this consent for the future;

-) according to Art. 77 GDPR to complain to a supervisory authority. As a rule, you can contact the supervisory authority of your usual place of residence or work or our company headquarters.
-) provided that your personal data are processed on the basis of legitimate interests in accordance with Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 f) GDPR, pursuant to Art. 21 GDPR opposition to the processing of your personal data, as far as there are reasons for this arising from your particular situation or the opposition is directed against direct mail. In the latter case, you have a general right of objection, which is implemented by us without stating a particular situation.
